Application Requirements

NFA strongly recommend that all applicants are thoroughly conversant with their responsibilities under the relevant Regulations before submitting a formal application for advice.

Information required

1. Application Form - To be completed **in full**
2. Certification from a suitably qualified Fire Engineer stating that the structural fire protection elements, fire cell calculations and any proposed fire suppression and detection systems comply with the National Building Code of Fiji.
3. Required fee or purchase order.

Along with the above items - the following information is required to accompany your application:-

1. Three (3) sets of clear and legible plans of the site/premises drawn to scale. One set of plans will be retained by NFA.
Note A set of plans should show:
 - a. Site plan showing all boundaries, entrances, structures and details and boundary offsets of adjoining premises.
 - b. Floor plan of all structures showing all doors, exits and production equipment where applicable.
 - c. Elevations
 - d. The location of existing and/or preferred fire detection and suppression equipment.
 - e. Existing fire detection and suppression equipment (hydrants, hose reels, extinguishers etc)
 - f. Location and distance from the entrance(s) of street hydrants.
 - g. Fire service plumbing and pipe work including size of street mains.
 - h. Location, class and quantity of all dangerous goods located on the site.
2. Additional required information
 - a. List Dangerous Goods Class, Quantity and Packaging Groups.
 - b. Location of fuel, LPG or other flammable material storage
